

Farewell, Bob



Robert C. Paris of Danbury died peacefully Sunday, November 30, 2008 at Danbury Hospital surrounded by his family. He was the beloved husband of Barbara Rosso Paris. Born in Sherbrook, Quebec, Canada, Bob graduated from Ridgefield High as president of his class. He was the proprietor of Decorator and Hardware Emporium in Danbury. In addition, for over 50 years, he was a nationally-known western style square dance caller, founding the Bethel Circle B and the Newtown Rocking Roosters clubs, and teaching lessons and calling for clubs all over New England, and in New York and New Jersey. His charismatic personality and infectious smile made him many friends, and his family joked that they could never go anywhere without running into someone he knew. During his illness, he received over a thousand cards. He loved fishing, boating, Rhode Island beaches and his dog Oliver, but his greatest love was his grandchildren, of whom he was very proud. Besides his wife of 57 years, he is survived by his daughters and their spouses: Lynne and Mark Purtle of New Fairfield, and Marcia and James Rossetti of Norwalk; his son and wife. Mark and Heather Paris of Danbury; his grandchildren, Justin, Joshua and James Purtle, Kristen and Matthew Rossetti, Monica Pirone, and Jordan, Taylor and Olivia Paris and a brother, Lloyd Paris of VT.

A memorial service will be held at a later time.
